Co-ordinator Checklist

Months Before...

-Contract: Review and return with the deposit.

-Make transportation arrangements.

-Consider **fundraising** to assist with the cost.

-Seek out **supervisors** - At least one supervisor for 30 students. Fees do not apply for supervisors at a ratio of 1:10. Supervisors in excess are welcome but will be charged at the group rate.

-Contact us if you with to have a student/parent **information session** about your trip.

-Send out school permission forms.

Weeks Before...

-Confirm **schedule** and program activities.

-Return Dietary Needs and Birthdays Form.

-Confirm Cabin Groups & Activity Groups.

-Send students home with Packing List and Photo/Video Release Form (if required).

Days Before...

-Confirm student and supervisor **numbers** with camp.

-Prepare a **cheque** made payable to *Camp Davern*.

-Review Packing List with students & Tuck Shoppe regulations.

-Remind Students of **bagged lunch** (Nut Free) for the first day.

-Remind students to return the Photo/Video Release Form (if required).

Camp Can-Aqua

Teacher/Supervisor Role

The camp program staff and your school's teachers/supervisors must work together effectively to create a safe and enjoyable excursion for everyone. Please note that supervisors are free of charge at a ratio of 10:1. Other adults are welcome to join, but will be charged at the group rate.

Teachers/Supervisors will...

-Respect and abide by Camp Davern rules and policies. (We are a drug, alcohol and smoke free facility).

-Maintain acceptable standards of behaviour amongst students. Camp staff will assist in maintaining satisfactory behaviour, but teachers have the main responsibility in behaviour management.

-Enforce Wake Up and Lights Out.

-Provide cabin supervision at night

-Assist in the supervision of students during meal times, activities and free time.

-Be responsible for dispensing, monitoring and recording students' medications.

-Have fun, engage, relax and enjoy!

The Tuck Shoppe
